The camp will be opened and staffed for activities from 9-5 PM.

Check-in will run from 8:45-12 PM.

Collin County Adventure Camp Activities:

All activities will be open throughout the day. Due to low numbers, we aren't scheduling each group at a specific time but we do ask that you maintain 6 ft of social distancing when at activities. If you are unable to do that, we are encouraging masks.

Lunch will be provided around 12 PM in the Dining Hall, we are still working with camp on exact times. We ask that you wear your mask through the lunch line. Once you get to your table you may remove your mask and you may also sit outside.

Other Information for the Camp:

- Check-in will be at the dining hall, we will be doing the Covid health screenings at this time as well.
- The fishing is great here! So make sure you bring a fishing pole and some bait. There will also be some fishing poles available at camp.
- Make sure you bring layers, a waterbottle, snacks (if needed), sunscreen, bug spray, etc.
- Please make sure you wait for a camp staff member prior to starting activities, with the exception of fishing.
- There is lots of walking at this camp. If your child can bike without training wheels, this is a great place to bike from activity to activity.
- There are hidden hiking trails all over so ask a camp staff if you want to do some hiking.
- Waterfront- there is no swimming at this camp. Everyone must wear a lifejacket while canoeing.
- Remember you are in charge of your child so please make sure you have an eye on your kid.
- Please remember all YMCA functions are drug and alcohol free.

To Camp:

- From Dallas/Fort Worth (about 35 miles): Follow US-75 North
- Follow US-75 N to State Hwy 121 N/TX-121 N in Melissa. Take exit 45 from US 75 N.
- Continue to State Hwy 121 N/TX-121 N
- Turn left on Co Rd 509
- Turn right on Co Rd 424
- Turn left on Co Rd 511
- Turn right on W Houston St
- Turn left onto Adventure Way

Safety and COVID-19 Guidelines:

In accordance with state and local health officials, the YMCA of Metropolitan Dallas is requiring the use of face masks during programming and encouraging social distancing throughout all our programming areas. See the list of guidelines for our Kick Off event:

- Use of facemasks will be required during all programming. Facemasks may be removed when physically exerting, swimming or engaging in other water activities, and when eating or drinking.
- Social distancing is encouraged wherever patrons are able.
- Trained staff will be conducting temperature checks on all parents and children arriving for the kick-off event. If a parent or child arrives with a temperature above 100.3°F, they will be asked to leave the premises.
- Lifejackets will be required for all persons engaging in waterfront activities. You may bring your own if it is U.S. Coast Guard Approved. The YMCA will also have lifejackets available for use.
- Regular and frequent handwashing is encouraged. Camp on the Lake will have 3 different stations located throughout the property for patrons to wash their hands. We will also distribute hand sanitizer to those that would like it.
- YMCA staff will clean and disinfect program equipment (BB guns, Bows, balls, etc.) between activity periods.

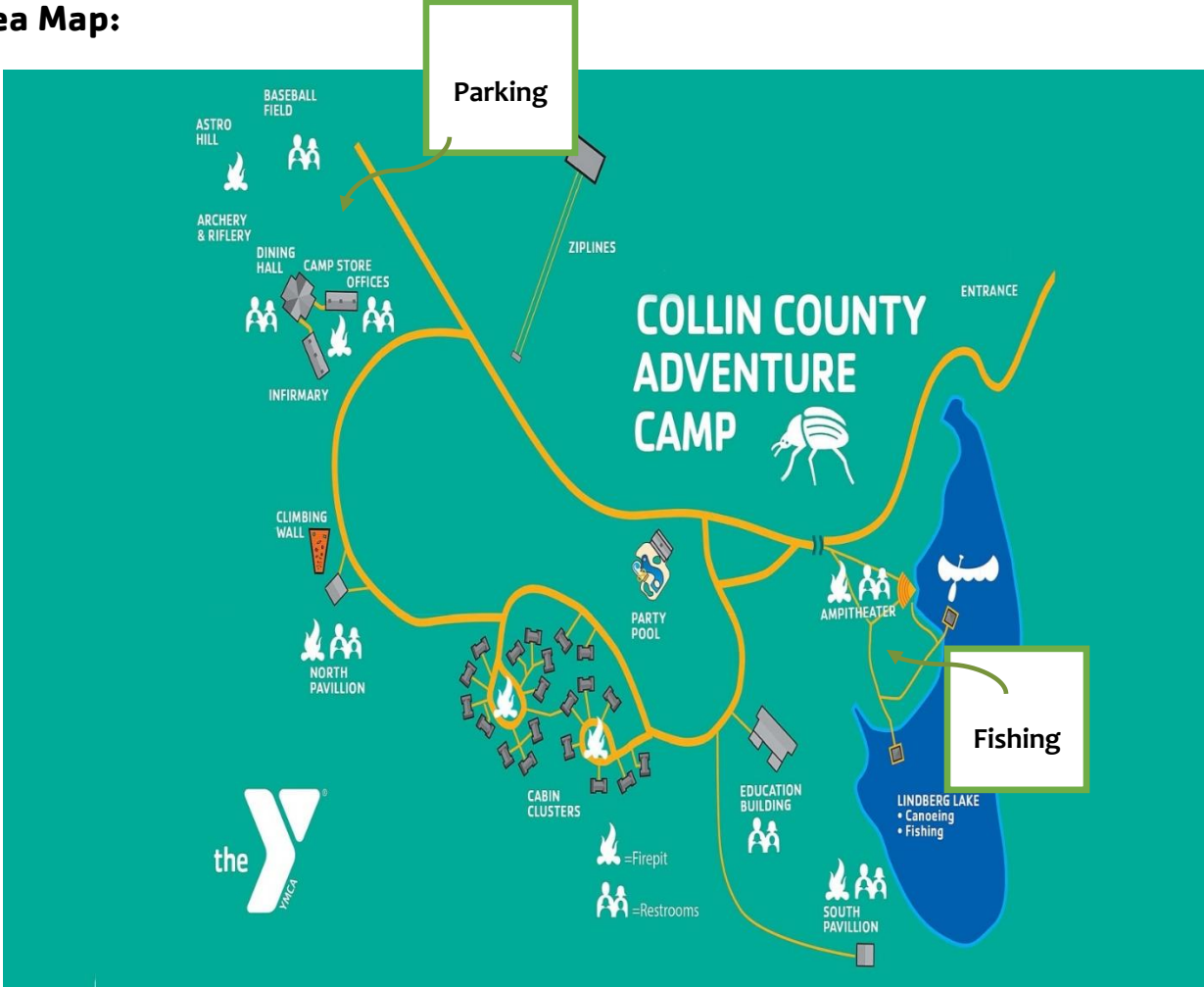
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Area Map:



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
