- Candidates must be available to attend interviews on either Saturday, February 4th or February 11th, 2023, from 7:30am to 12:30pm. In case of inclement weather, please, be available for the makeup date of Tuesday, February 15th 2023, from 5:30 to 9:30pm. **No other interview date will be made available. If a date is out of the question, please, note that here: _____.**

Observe the deadline –postmarked by Wednesday, January 11, 2023. Only official H.S. transcripts are accepted. Copies of SAT or ACT records will be accepted. Upon receipt of all requested materials, a scholarship committee will review the information. In fairness to all applicants, the Scholarship Review Panel consists of volunteers only. Due to the high volume of questions, inquiries will only be accepted via email at collegescholarship@ymcadallas.org. Remember, if selected, candidates must be available to attend interviews on Saturday, February 4th, or February 11th, 2023, from 7:30am to 12:30pm (or inclement weather makeup date of February 15th.)

You are required to stay for the entire time. No other interview date will be made available.



Dallas YMCA Y Scholar College Scholarship Guidelines

I understand that if chosen to receive a scholarship, I must abide by the following guidelines. Failure to comply with any of the listed requirements will result in a forfeiture of the funding of my scholarship for that semester. If I miss (3) funding deadlines or my GPA drops below the requirement, I further understand that I will no longer be eligible for the remainder of my scholarship.

- Take a minimum of 12 hours per semester.
- Maintain at least a 2.5 GPA to remain in the Dallas YMCA Scholarship Program
- Return the following documents every semester
 - a. Renewal Form (Emailed from college scholarship office 1 month before it is due back)
 - b. Previous semester transcript (Does not have to be the official transcript but we do have to see that it was downloaded from your college's site)
 - c. Upcoming semester schedule
 - d. Progress Letter (Short letter that tells what activities you are involved in, challenges you have faced in the last semester, what you are looking forward to in the upcoming semester, etc.)
